Overnight Flight → 1 night

Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Buenos Aires today.

Buenos Aires → 1 night

Day 2: Arrival in Buenos Aires

Included meals: welcome dinner

Welcome to Argentina! Touch down in Buenos Aires, where you'll meet your fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Ushuaia → 1 night

Day 3: Flight to Ushuaia

Included meals: breakfast

Fly to Ushuaia and get acquainted with the city on a guided walking tour. Then, spend the rest of the day exploring on your own.

Overnight Cruise → 9 nights

Day 4: Cruise embarkation

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

Travel through coastal landscapes and glacial valleys on an excursion to Tierra del Fuego National Park before boarding a cruise ship bound for the Antarctic.

- Visit Bahia Ensenada and view evidence of the 6,500-year-old native settlements
- Take in views of Roca Lake and Lapataia Bay

Day 5: Day at sea

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Spend the day crossing the legendary Drake Passage.

Day 6: Day at sea

Spend another day crossing the legendary Drake Passage.

Day 7: South Shetland Islands

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Start your four-day exploration of the rocky South Shetland Islands and the northernmost tip of the Antarctic continent.

- Visit penguin rookeries
- Cruise through Neptune's Bellows into the natural harbor at Deception Island

Day 8: King George & Livingston Islands

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Encounter Adélie and chinstrap penguins on King George Island and come face-to-face with elephant seals on Livingston Island. *Please note: Your Antarctica itinerary is weather-dependent.*

Day 9: Lemaire & Neumayer Channels

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Cruise along the Antarctic coast in the Gerlache Strait and gaze in awe at the towering sea cliffs lining the Lemaire and Neumayer Channels. You might also make stops at Paulet Island, the Melchior Islands and Portal Point. *Please note: Your Antarctica itinerary is weather-dependent.*

Day 10: Antarctic Islands

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Enjoy your final day of cruising in Antarctica. Depending on your ship's itinerary, you may:

- Discover the gentoo penguin rookery and the towering icebergs of Cuverville Island
- Spy the calving icebergs at Neko Harbor
- View the shallow bay filled with resting icebergs at Pleneau Island
- Visit the world's southernmost colony of gentoo penguins at Petermann Island
- Venture into the placid waters of Paradise Bay, where the sea serves as a mirror for the surrounding mountains

Day 11: Day at sea

Begin the first of two days of uninterrupted cruising back to South America. Join the ship's lecturers and naturalists on deck for whale- and bird-watching.

Spend another day cruising to the South American mainland.

Day 13: Cruise disembarkation & flight to Buenos Aires

Before heading home, take in the highlights of Buenos Aires on a guided sightseeing tour.

- Visit the beautiful Plaza de Mayo to see the Casa Rosada, the Metropolitan Cathedral and the Cabildo
- Pass through the historic neighborhood of San Telmo before exploring the colorful streets of La Boca
- Drive along 9 de Julio Avenue, the widest street in the world, to Palermo and its beautiful parks
- Visit the aristocratic Recoleta neighborhood and the grave of Eva Perón

Day 15: Estancia Visit: Argentine Barbecue & Gaucho Show

Head to Argentina's countryside for a day at a traditional estancia, or ranch, where you'll get to know the culture of the Pampas. You'll be welcomed with empanadas, a local specialty, and Argentine wine, then have a chance to visit the estancia's museum and church. Later, enjoy a delicious barbecue lunch along with entertainment. Experience the folklore of the region through music, dance, and a horse-riding show as gauchos (traditional ranch hands) show off their skills in the center of the ring, or sortija.
